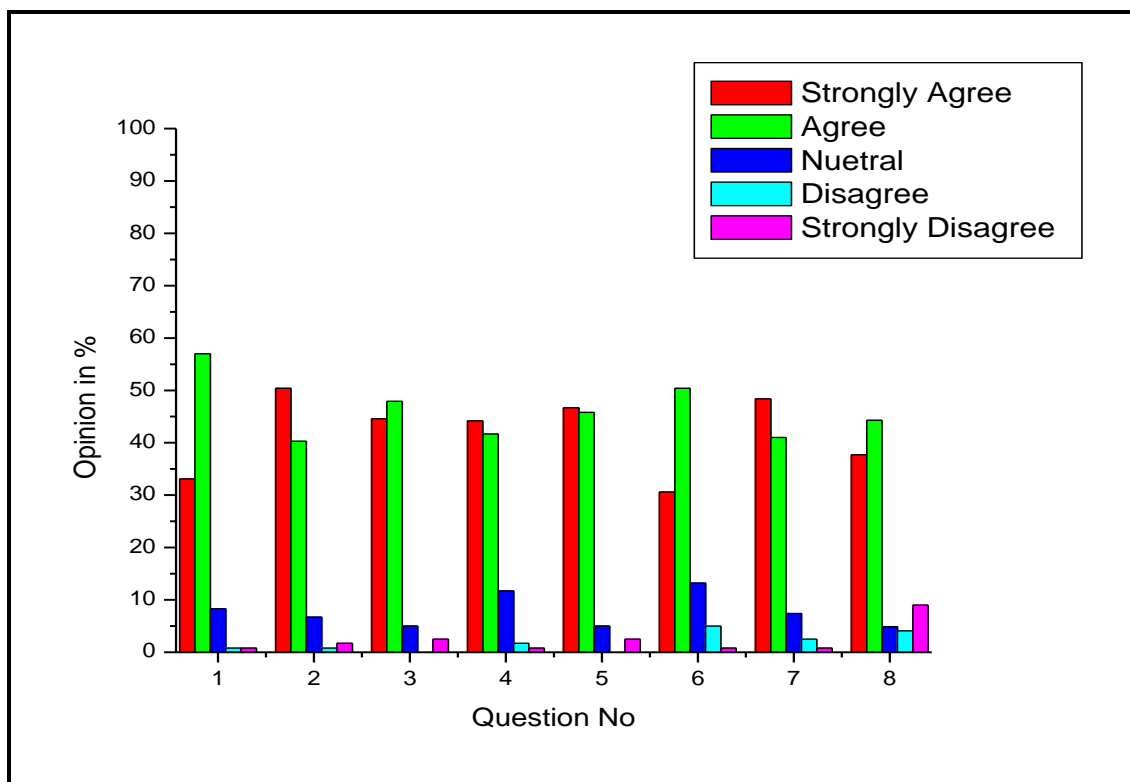

Analysis:

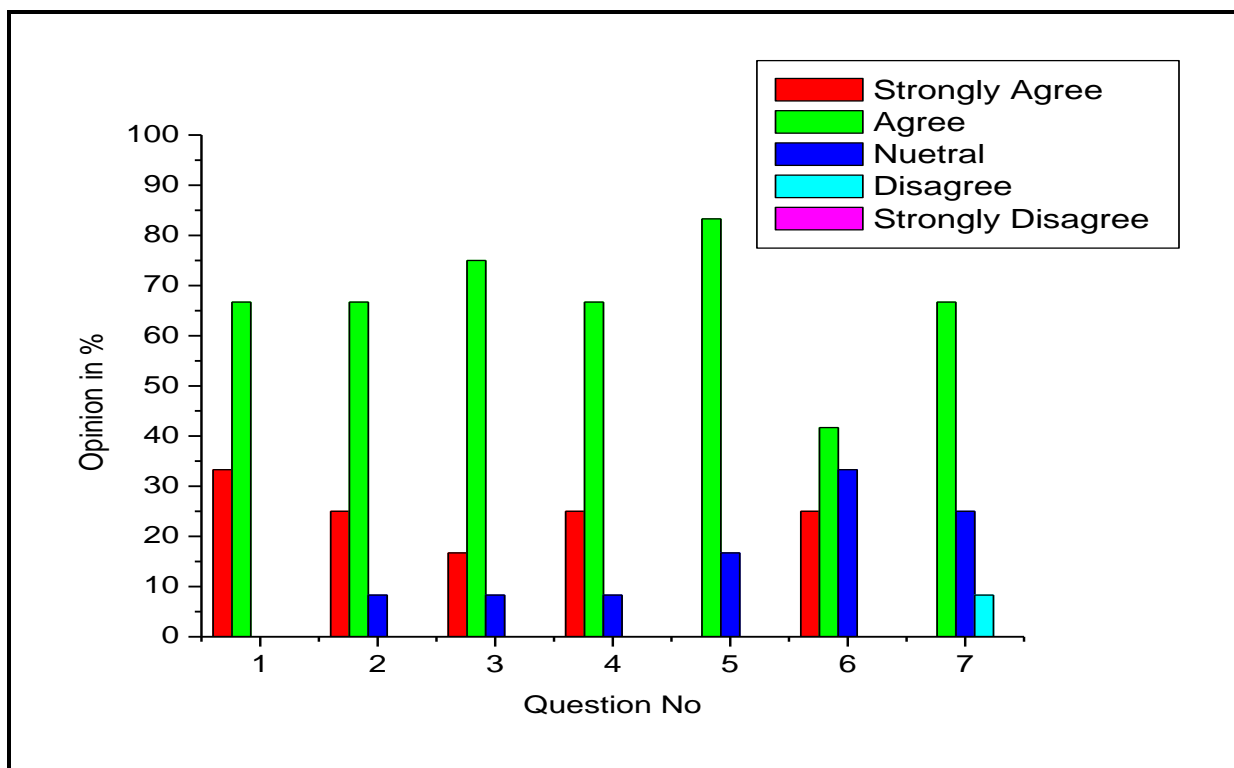
1. 90.1 % of students believe that curriculum is updated enough.

6. 66.7 % teachers believe that there is a need of review of syllabus.

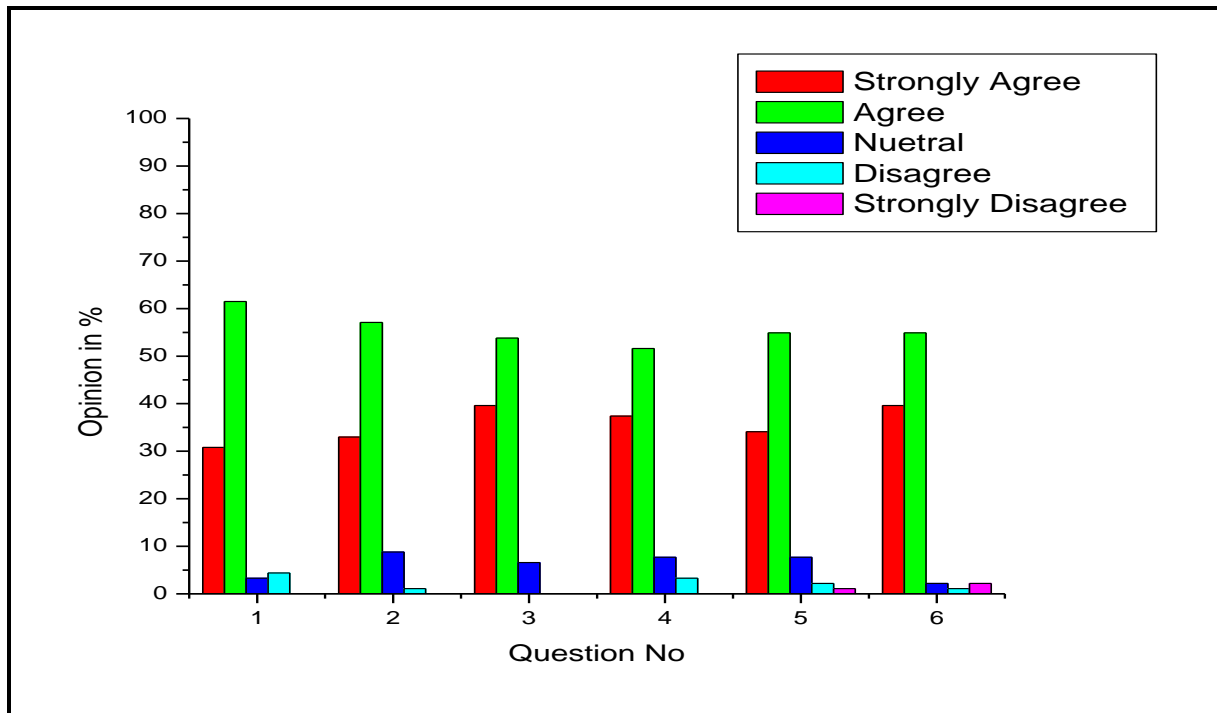
Suggestion:

Analysis:

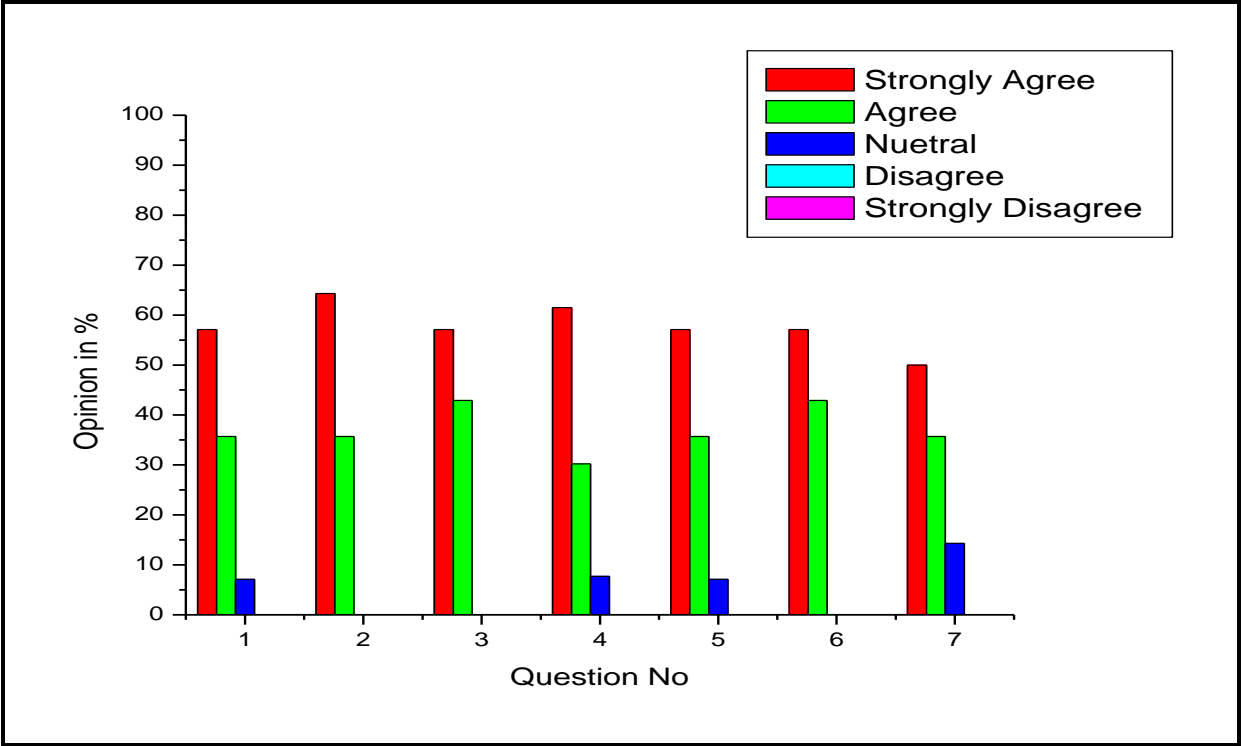
1. 92.3 % parents believe that syllabus of their ward having current content.


Analysis:
